

FUND MANAGER COMMENTARY

Indonesia local government bond market reported negative movement in March 2022 with Bloomberg EM Local Currency: Indonesia Total Return Index Unhedged IDR went down by -0.82% on monthly basis, while the IDR Prime Fixed Income Fund performance reported -0.66% return in the same month. The 10Yr IDR government bond underwent correction with yield increased by +22 bps to 6.73% in March 2022. Market sentiments were driven by US Federal Reserve rate hike, +25 bps in March 2022 and open for another +50bps hike in May 2022, high inflation number globally and geopolitical tension. On the domestic monetary side, Bank Indonesia maintained its policy rate 7D-RRR at 3.5%, but increased reserve requirement ratio by +150 bps in March 2022.

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
